Amendment to Norfolk County Council Bye Laws on the Employment of Children

In order to ensure that the local bye laws reflect the legislative changes, the following amendment to the current bye laws need to be made.

Under the section

Permitted Employment of Children aged 13

Bye law 5 - A child aged 13 may not be employed except in light work in one or more of the following specified categories

(a) reads – agricultural or horticultural work

This statement requires an addition and should now read

(a) agricultural or horticultural work on an occasional basis under the direct supervision of their parents or guardians
