THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HUNSTANTON, ST EDMUNDS TERRACE) (PEDESTRIAN ZONE, PROHIBITION OF ENTRY, PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES AND RESTRICTED ZONE) ORDER 2015

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

In this Order:

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

"Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 vehicles" have the same meaning as in section 3 of The Use of Invalid Carriages on Highways Regulations 1988.

"cycle" has the same meaning as in section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in contravention of this Order means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left at that contravention;

"General Directions" shall mean the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"Heavy Commercial Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 138 of the Act;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988";

"prohibited area" means that area specified in Article 5 and Schedule 2 of this Order indicated on site by Sign 617 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

- 1. Save as provided in Articles 2, 4, 5 and 6 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed at any time along the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 5 of this Order, nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent a person from causing a vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in the Schedules to this Order if the vehicle being used requires access to:-
 - (i) private property situated adjacent to that length of road;

- (ii) the rear access of private property situated on:-
 - (a) the west side of the C499 High Street from its junction with the C482 Westgate to its junction with the C481 Greevegate;
 - (b) the south side of the C481 Greevegate from its junction with the C499 High Street to its junction with the U20037/10 St Edmunds Terrace (north/south length);
 - (c) The east side of the U20037/10 St Edmunds Terrace (north/south length) from its junction with the C481 Greevegate to its junction with the C482 Westgate;
- (iv) Property No 10 St Edmunds Terrace (currently Marine Hotel).
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer, cause any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time along the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order, nothing in Articles 1 and 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed, wait, load or unload in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act as 1984;
 - (d) is for the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to be in the prohibited area specified in Schedule 2 to this Order on Monday to Sunday from 1000 hours to 2300 hours.
- 6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to be in the prohibited area specified in Article 5 if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;

- (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act as 1984;
- (d) is an unridden cycle;
- (e) is a Class 1 or Class 2 vehicle.
- 7. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the U20037/20 St Edmunds Terrace (east/west length) at its easternmost junction with the C482 Westgate.
- 8. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of October 2015 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Hunstanton, St Edmunds Terrace)(Pedestrian Zone, Prohibition of Entry, Prohibition of Vehicles and Restricted Zone) Order 2015.
- 9. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Hunstanton, St Edmunds Terrace)(Pedestrian Zone, Prohibition of Entry and Restricted Zone) Order 2013" – in its entirety.

10. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
