# THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (BRISTON, FAKENHAM ROAD - SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR/CLEARWAY AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2017

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Briston, Fakenham Road – School Keep Clear/Clearway and Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2017 shall come into effect on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 2017.

#### 2. In this Order -

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

"Emergency vehicle" providing a response to an emergency request of an NHS ambulance service:

"General Directions" shall mean The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016"

"School keep clear/clearway" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 in Part 6 of Schedule 7 of the General Directions".

- 3. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the school keep clear/clearway in length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person, shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 of this Order at any time.

- 6. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road or on the side of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
  - (a) goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (b) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of roads; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984:
    - (v) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011:
  - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- 6. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege.
- 7. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
- 8. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with the effect of markings placed on the carriageway and signs as specified in Schedule 14 of the General Directions conveying the existence of:-
  - (a) a 'bus stop/clearway'; or
  - (b) (i) a toucan or equestrian crossing; or
    - (ii) Zebra Pedestrian Crossing or Zebra controlled area; or
    - (iii) Pelican Pedestrian Crossing or Pelican controlled area; or
    - (iv) Puffin Pedestrian Crossing or Puffin controlled area;

and established as specified in s23(2) of the 1984 Act, the effect of those markings shall prevail.
