## THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HOPTON-ON-SEA, WARREN ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2020

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2), 122, and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "The Norfolk County Council (Hopton-On-Sea, Beach Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2020 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 2020.
- 2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Unless the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

"cycle" has the same meaning as in section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988";

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the motor vehicle being used:
  - (a) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Communications Act 2003;
  - (d) for the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
  - (e) requires access to a property situated along the length of the restriction.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
