THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PORINGLAND, CARR LANE) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2019

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Poringland, Carr Lane) (Prohibition Of Motor Vehicles) Order 2019 and shall come into effect on the 30th day of September 2019.
- 2. In this Order:
 - "Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 vehicles" have the same meaning as in Regulation 3 of The Use of Invalid Carriages on Highways Regulations 1988.
 - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988";
- 3. Save as provided in Article 2, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is any of the following:-
 - (a) a Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 vehicle;
 - (b) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes:
 - (c) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984:
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Poringland

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

U78151 Carr Lane (north – south)

- From a point 177 metres north of its junction with the C187 Shotesham Road northwards for a distance of 217 metres.

(east - west)

U78151 Carr Lane From a point 200 metres west of its junction with the B1332 The Street south-westwards to its junction with the 7P244 Victory Avenue footpath.
