
THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (GREAT YARMOUTH, MARKET PLACE) (RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2020

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(4), 3(2) and 122 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Market Place) (Right Turn) Order 2020 and shall come into effect on the 20th day of July 2020.
- 2. Article 8 of The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Entry, Right, Left and 'U' Turns Order 2015 is deleted and replaced with the following wording:-
 - "8. Unless otherwise directed by a Police Constable in uniform, any vehicle proceeding northbound along the C610 Market Place shall be permitted to:-
 - (i) turn left into the U60304 The Conge at its junction with the U60304 The Conge; or
 - (ii) turn right from the eastern length of the C610/200 Market Place from a point 43 metres south of its junction with the B1141/60 Fullers Hill.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of roads specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
