## THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ATTLEBOROUGH, QUEENS SQUARE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2020

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Church Street, Queens Square, Queens Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 2020 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2020.
- 2. The Norfolk County Council (Attleborough, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2014 is amended by the addition of the references as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
