Planning Inspectorate (Reg 22) March 2022. Examination expected to finish
end of year 2022; Main Modifications autumn 2022; adoption spring 2023.

## **Norfolk County Council**

 M&W Local Plan Review (2036): Reg 18 consultation on the Preferred Options took place between 18 September to 30 October 2019. Reg 19 presubmission expected Q3 2022.

## **North Norfolk**

- Local Plan Review: Commenced August 2015
- Local Plan 2016-2036 Core Strategy including Development Management Policies and Site Allocation Plan: Call for sites undertaken. Reg 18 Consultation May 2019. Pre-Submission Reg 19 January-February 2022. Submission to Secretary of State/ Planning Inspectorate (Reg 22) expected Aug/Sept 2022.

## **Norwich City**

- Greater Norwich Local Plan: Reg 22 Local Plan Submitted for examination on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021. Examination Hearings expected January to March 2022 with additional hearings planned including an additional hearing for East Norwich 6<sup>th</sup> July. Adoption is currently anticipated April 2023.
- East Norwich Masterplan: Stage 1 approved at Cabinet November 2021 (high level masterplan based on a preferred option, understanding of strategic infrastructure needs, other costs, and impact on deliverability). Stage 2 completed by May 2022 (includes Infrastructure Delivery Plan and Strategic

Viability Assessment to inform a refined version of the masterplan). Stage 2 was reported to Cabinet in June 2022 where the masterplan was approved, and other outputs were endorsed. This work will form the basis of a new East Norwich SPD to support the policy within the GNLP and will be adopted in Spring 2023 following, or alongside, the GNLP

# **South Norfolk**

- Greater Norwich Local Plan: Reg 22 Local Plan Submitted for examination on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021. Examination Hearings expected January to March 2022. Adoption is likely to be late 2022.
- Village Clusters Housing Allocations Plan: Regulation 19 Consultation expected in March 2022. Submission to Secretary of State intended autumn 2022; adoption expected 2023.
