THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (SCHOOL STREETS) (PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2022

The Norfolk County Council has made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to create pedestrian and cycle zones adjacent to local schools listed in the Schedule below. This is to encourage the use of walking and cycling as a mode of travel to school and to create a safe traffic free environment in which to do so. This will be between the hours of 08:15 -09:15 and 14:30 – 15:30 Monday to Friday when schools are open to pupils.

This Order will come into force on the 3rd May 2022 and remain in force for 18 months. During this period the Norfolk County Council may modify or suspend the operation of the Order and will be considering whether to make the Order permanent.

This experiment will involve the closure of the roads listed in Schedule 1 below by way of temporary barriers and entry along those roads will be permitted by School Street Stewards to holders of permits issued to those eligible from properties set out in Schedule 2 below.

This Experimental Order will be in force for a period not exceeding 18 months. However, consideration will be given in due course as to whether to make an Order for its provisions to continue in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning with the 22nd April 2022 or if this Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

The provisions of this Order are experimental and the Executive Director Community and Environmental Services at Norfolk County Council, or a person authorised by him is authorised to make changes if necessary for safety and operational reasons as set out in Section 10 (2) (a), (b) and (c) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

However, please be aware that due to the pandemic staffing levels have been reduced and viewing online would be recommended in keeping with the government guidelines.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 19th April 2022 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
