Dereham Road travel improvements - Project update

Following on from our previous communications regarding the ongoing Transforming Cities works taking place along Dereham Road and at the Bowthorpe Travel Hub, a new road closure will be implemented, as outlined below:

Breckland Road - Road Closure

Once the current resurfacing works have been completed between the Three Mile Lane junction and the northern roundabout exit/island, this section of road will be reopened.

A new road closure will then be implemented to complete further carriageway works on the opposite side between the Breckland Road junction with Dereham Road and the northern roundabout entrance / island. This 24-hour road closure will commence on 2 April 2024 and run for a total of 10 weeks until 7 June 2024.

The diversion route for general traffic is via: Breckland Road, Upper Breckland Road, Three Mile Lane and Dereham Road.

Temporary Bus Stops

The existing bus stops located on Breckland Road, near the subway crossing will be temporarily suspended during these improvement works; a pair of temporary bus stops will be provided on Three Mile Lane near the bus gate.

We thank you for your continued patience while this work takes place. We aim to minimise any inconvenience and will complete all work as quickly as possible.
