# Norfolk County Council Workforce Report 2024

### Statement on the data

Under section 149 of the Equality Act 2010 (the Public Sector Equality Duty (PSED)) and the Equality Act 2010 (Specific Duties) Regulations 2011, we are required to publish equality information to demonstrate our compliance with the general equality duty. Our workforce monitoring data forms part of the information that we collate, monitor and publish to help us embed equality considerations in our employment policies and practices and meet our responsibilities under the duty. This report provides an overview of our equality and diversity employment monitoring data for the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024. It covers age, disability, ethnicity, religion or belief, gender, and sexual orientation. It also includes information on working patterns, pay bands, organisational starters and leavers, and recruitment processes. In previous years this report has not included Fire Retained Staff amongst Norfolk County Council's workforce data. However, in this report Fire Retained Staff have been included to ensure that the report is representative of the entire workforce. In light of this change, caution should be taken when comparing this report to previous reports of its kind. Figures have been rounded to the nearest whole number and small figures (below 1%) have been suppressed to prevent identification of individuals. Therefore, due to rounding and suppression, some figures may not total.

### **Changes to Data from Previous Year**

Over the last year, Norfolk County Council made improvements to equality categories to align with best practise. As a result of these improvements employees were encouraged to review their Equality data held on our HR and Finance system and to update their records with any changes. As part of the communication with the workforce, we explained the importance of NCC having a good understanding of the workforce profile to help us embed equality considerations in our employment policies and practices, as well as meeting our responsibilities under the Equality Act 2010 (the Public Sector Equality Duty (PSED)) and the Equality Act 2010 (Specific Duties) Regulations 2011. This resulted in a decrease in the 'No Data Recorded' group across the workforce. A new HR and Finance system was implemented in 2022. As the system becomes more embedded, we have taken the opportunity to review our data categories and methodology. This has enabled us to review and identify improvements in different areas of employment. For example, the method for identifying casual workers has been updated as there were multiple methods to enter casual worker

data on the system. We now have a more robust system to remove casual worker data which has resulted in the employee headcount being lower this year from the 2022-23 report. Likewise we have improved our methodology for determining Full and Part time working arrangements, which has resulted in a variance in this data to the 2022-23 report.
