

KlangHaus

In February 2014, Norfolk County Council awarded Arts Project funding to Norfolk-based band The Neutrinos to stage a preview of their show KlangHaus at Norwich Arts Centre on 10 May 2014 as part of the Norfolk & Norwich Live Art Festival.

The show formed part of their development and research to take KlangHaus to the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in August 2014, to perform at the prestigious Summerhall venue with funding from the Escalator East To Edinburgh Scheme.

The show represents extremes of performance with small audiences in intimate spaces. A 360 degrees visceral, immersive experience challenging the conventions of the music/gig experience, using sound, colour, live music, projections and disorientating imagery to alter audience perceptions.

KlangHaus was a great success in at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival receiving 4 and 5 star reviews from the national press.
