

The Norfolk Community Directory is Norfolk County Council’s on-line directory of services and things to do. The directory forms part of the Local Offer website.

The directory:

- has over 3900 services and organisations listed, of these over 1940 are for children and young people with SEND
- can be searched using keywords, location or categories
- the results from searches can be filtered by a range of features, such as age range, accessibility features, time and date of sessions.

Once you have searched and filtered the results you can view the services or organisations details, which would normally include:

- details of what the service or organisation does
- their contact details
- a link to their website
- who they provide services for, including age range
