## Have your say

Every local authority must publish what special educational provision and special training provision it expects schools, early years and post-16 providers to make available.

Representatives from early years, schools, post-16 settings, Family Voice Norfolk and Norfolk County Council have shared their knowledge and expertise of good practice in SEN support to define and set out:

- The expectations regarding SEN support and the graduated approach and when this may lead to an EHCP needs assessment
- When additional Cluster funding may be required in order to 'top-up' the school SEN provision in order to meet needs
- How it expects schools, early years and post-16 providers to use their delegated budget
- An evidence base for improving progress and securing better outcomes
- What parents/carers can expect their child's setting to provide.
