If you don't live near a library, there will be a **mobile library** stop near you.

- ★ When you join the library, you can borrow and return items using **any Norfolk library**
- ★ You can borrow **anything you are interested in** – just ask if you want to be shown books written for young people
- ★ Young people can ask for **anything in any library in Norfolk to be sent to the library of your choice to be picked up – free!**

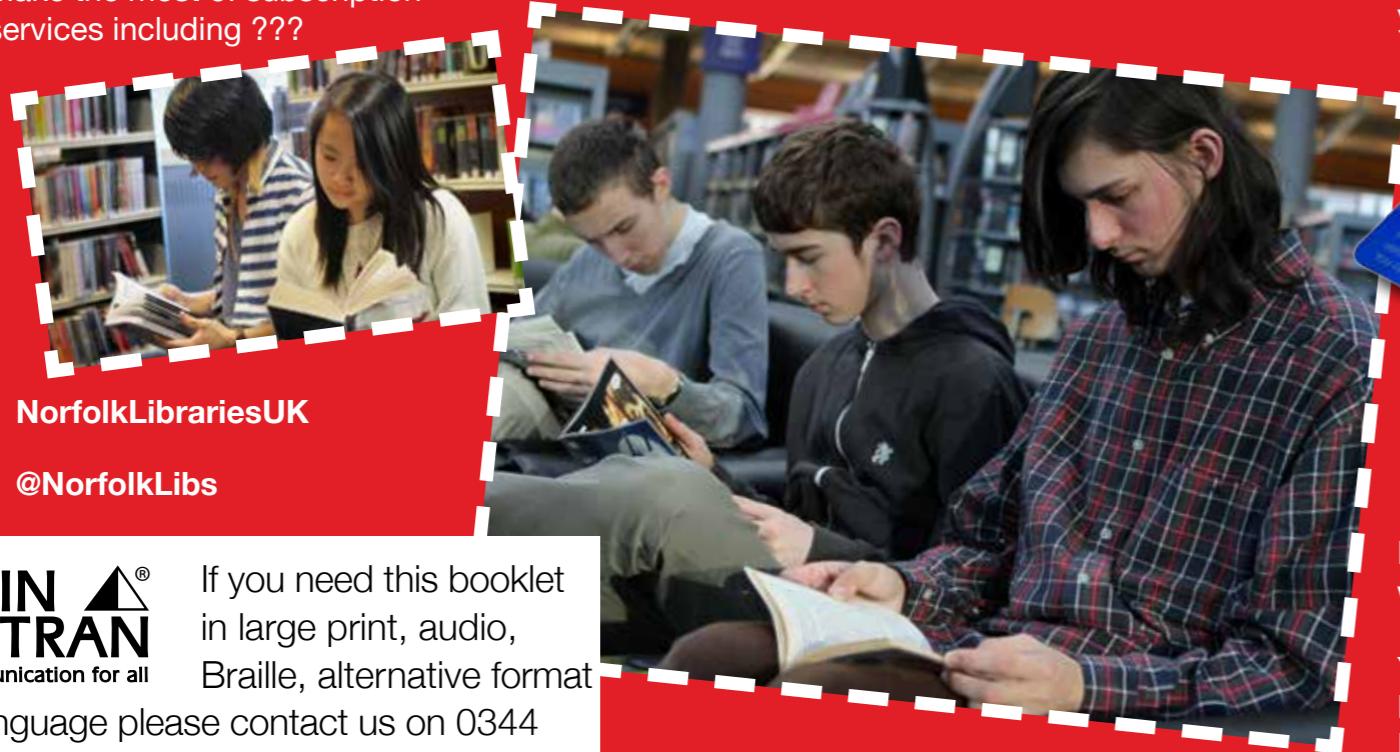




WE ARE HERE TO HELP
