## 50 miles > Fen Rivers Way



The Fen Rivers Way runs for nearly 50 miles between the historic settlements of King's Lynn and Cambridge, tracing the course of rivers that drain slowly across the Fens into the Wash.

The distinctive fenland landscape has been heavily influenced by man. Its fertile agricultural land is dissected by dykes, rivers and embankments, constructed over centuries in the struggle to reclaim the land. The area is dominated by dramatic open landscapes and vast skies.
