Peddars Way



The Peddars Way follows a Roman road that may have been built along the line of an even older trackway. It runs northwards from Knettishall Heath in Suffolk, for 46 miles through the diverse Norfolk countryside to the north Norfolk coast at Holme-Next-The-Sea near Hunstanton. The name of this trail is said to be derived from the Latin *pedester*, which means "on foot".
