Church Street, Bawburgh – Emergency Closure for Bridge Repairs

A routine inspection of TG10114 Church Street Bridge, Bawburgh has shown that the bridge needed to be closed as an emergency. It was found that the bridge had become significantly undermined and therefore unsafe to take vehicular loading. This means no vehicles can use this bridge currently due to the risk of collapse.

The repair work will start as soon as possible. **The road bridge will need to remain closed to vehicles until the repair work is completed.** The bridge remains open to pedestrians only at this time.

The brick arch road bridge is located on Church Street/ Bawburgh Road, Bawburgh. It crosses a small watercourse. It is located approx. 25m north from the junction with the B1108.

Emergency work will be carried out by Norfolk County Councils bridges contractor Tarmac at an estimated cost of £35,000.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while these essential bridge maintenance works are being carried out.

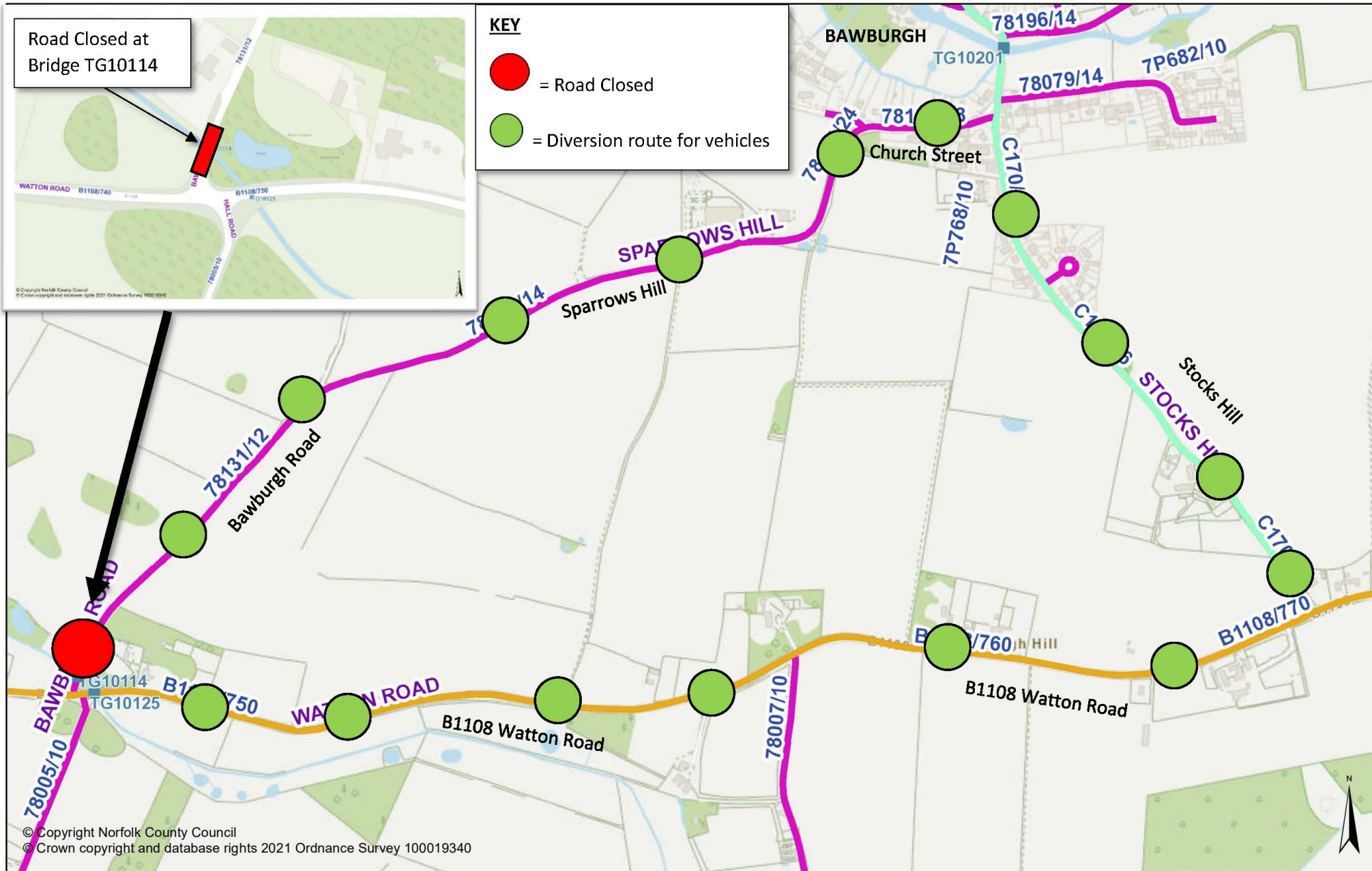
