## **Road closure on A149 Old Hunstanton Road, Old Hunstanton for carriageway resurfacing**

Work will begin on Monday 8 January to carry out major carriageway resurfacing works on A149 Old Hunstanton Road, Old Hunstanton. The works will take two weeks to complete subject to suitable weather conditions.

The site will extend from the junction with Church Road, Old Hunstanton through to the junction with Peddars Way, Holme-Next-The-Sea.

During the resurfacing works it will be necessary to close the road to all through traffic between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm each day until the work has been completed. A fully signed official diversion along roads of the same or higher classification via Heacham, Docking, Brancaster & Thornham will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Access to businesses and properties within the limits of the closure will be maintained from one end at all times but it is inevitable that there will be some disruption.

The County Council would like to thank people for their patience while these works to replace the existing worn out road surface are carried out.

The work which will cost £295,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community & Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
