Scole, Diss Road/The Street - Carriageway resurfacing

The junction of Diss Road and The Street will be resurfaced week commencing 27 November which should take 4 days to complete. Work will involve resurfacing the existing carriageway, and re-painting the carriageway lines.

The carriageway will be closed for the duration of the works, for the safety of the public and contractors working on the carriageway, but residents directly affected by the works will have access to their homes for the duration of the works.

A signed diversion route will be provided, and gatemen will be used to allow residents to safely access their properties.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this surfacing improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £62,400 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
