

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (GREAT YARMOUTH,
SOUTH BEACH PARADE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON FOOTWAY) AMENDMENT ORDER 2018**

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 32(1) and 35(1) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, South Beach Parade) (Prohibition of Waiting on Footway) Amendment Order 2018 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 26th day of March 2018.
2. The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, North Drive, Marine Parade and South Beach Parade) (Prohibition of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2012 (hereinafter referred to as the "2012 Order") will be amended as specified in Article 3 of this Order.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of the 2012 Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time along the lengths of footway on the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

No Stopping on Footway – At Any Time

C607 South Beach Parade East Side	From a point 63 metres south of the junction with the C629 Kings Road southwards for a distance of 279 metres.
	From its junction with the U60765 Dickens Avenue southwards for a distance of 456 metres.
