

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HOPTON-ON-SEA, WARREN ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2020**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Hopton-On-Sea, Warren Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 2020 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 13th day of January 2020.
2. The Norfolk County Council (Hopton, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2013 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2013 Order") is amended by the deletion and addition of the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

C600 Warren Road South-East Side	-	From a point 305 metres north of its junction with the U62226 Watsons Close northwards for a distance of 40 metres.

C600 Warren Road South-East Side	-	From a point 223 metres north-east of its junction with the U62226 Watsons Close northwards for a distance of 127 metres.
