**TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT**

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the **Fakenham Farmers Markets**, they have made a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on U14065 The Square, from its junction with C575 Market Place, heading southwest for 45m in the **PARISH of Fakenham** ("the Road").

**Fakenham Farmers Markets on Saturday 24th June, Saturday 29th July, Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> August, Saturday 30th September, Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October, Saturday 25th November & Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2023.**

The Order will come into effect on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2023 and will remain in force for 6hrs. The road(s) will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on June 24<sup>th</sup>, July 29<sup>th</sup>, August 26<sup>th</sup>, September 30<sup>th</sup>, October 28<sup>th</sup>, November 25<sup>th</sup>, and December 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 between **8am until 2pm** for the duration of the **Fakenham Farmers Markets 2023**. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.
