

The Commons Act 2006 – Section 19
Notice of an Application for the correction of the Commons Register

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

An application has been made to Norfolk County Council, the Commons Registration Authority for Norfolk, by Mr and Mrs Bradshaw under section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The applicants seek the correction of the commons map and registers for a parcel of land at Eaton Common registered under unit CL1, Eaton, Norwich. The applicant seeks the removal from registration as common of the parcel of land edged in red on the attached plan. The basis for the application is that this land parcel was excluded from the original application dated 29 March 1968 for the registration of common land at Eaton but was mistakenly included, by the Commons Registration Authority, in the provisional registration of 12 October 1967. This provisional registration, being undisputed, became final on 1 October 1970.

If the application is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by removing the land edged in red from the register of common land.

Representations:

- must quote the Application No. CL1 (NOR)/1/52978
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application, and may include an e-mail address
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and



The date on which the period for making representations expires is 12 May 2017.


