

The Commons Act 2006 – Section 19
Notice of an Application for the correction of the Commons Register

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

An application has been made to the Commons Registration Authority, Norfolk County Council, by Mr Steven Wade under section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The applicant seeks the correction of the commons map and registers of CL 50, Thwaite Common, in the Parish of Alby-with-Thwaite, Norfolk, by the removal of land (Area 'A') at Goose Lane Farmhouse, Thwaite Common, Erpingham, NR11 7QG as edged and shaded red on the plan accompanying the application. The basis of the application is that the land known as 'Area A' was excluded from the original application for registration of Thwaite Common dated 21 August 1967 but was mistakenly included by the Commons Registration Authority in the provisional registration of 17 October 1967, which being undisputed, became final on 1 August 1972.

If the application is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by removing the land from the register of common land.

Representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application, and may include an e-mail address
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and


