

MARAC Process in 9 Steps

Step 1

Disclosure of Domestic Violence

Step 2

Case is assessed as high risk
(see referral criteria on referral form)

Step 3

MARAC referral form completed by frontline worker
(Forwarded to MARAC Coordinator & cc MARAC rep)

Step 4

IDVA contacts the survivor
where consent has been provided

Step 5

MARAC meeting takes place

Step 6

All relevant information is shared

Step 7

IDVA brings the survivors' views
and safety concerns to the MARAC

Step 8

Action Plan developed

Step 9

Relevant actions reported to survivor by IDVA or
other professional where safe to do so
