## **EXECUTIVE KEY DECISION – 31 January 2022**

#### **Notice of Intention to take Key Decision without 28-Day Notice**

Notice is hereby given to the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee in accordance with Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that it was impracticable to give 28 days' notice of the intention to take the following decision, which is a Key Decision to be taken by the Cabinet on **31 January 2022**:

#### **Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) Funding**

The reason for which it has been impracticable to give 28 days' notice of this decision is as follows:

The report was added to the forward plan on the 10 August 2021. Unfortunately, due to officer error, the report was not marked as a key decision and this fact has only come to light as the report has been finalised.

The Council is required to take the decisions required by the report in line with statutory Government requirements relating to the setting of the Schools Budget, which means that the decision cannot wait until the March 2022 Cabinet meeting.
