Norfolk Police and Crime Panel – review of proposed precept for 2016-17, 2 February 2016, 10am, Edwards Room, County Hall

In accordance with Schedule 5 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, I write to confirm the Norfolk Police and Crime Panel's decision regarding your proposed precept for 2016-17.

With 9 votes for and 1 against, the Panel voted to veto your proposal of a council tax freeze on the basis that it was too low. Having weighed-up your reasons against the Chief Constable's arguments that the precept should be raised by the maximum amount, the Panel agreed that a freeze would not support the Constabulary to meet its future challenges.

As you will be aware, the next steps that we are required to take following a veto are as follows:

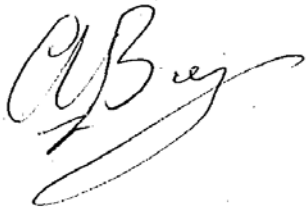
- 1) The Panel must make a report to the Commissioner by 8 February 2016 (this letter is the Panel's report to you; draft minutes of our consideration of your original precept proposal will be included in the paperwork for the 16 February 2016 meeting).
- 2) You are required to have regard to and respond to the Panel's report (this letter) and notify the Panel of your revised precept proposal by 15 February 2016.

- 3) The Panel is scheduled to meet on 10am on 16 February to review your revised precept proposal. It will make a second report to you by 22 February 2016.
- 4) You are then required to respond to the Panel's second report by 1 March 2016.
