Norfolk Police and Crime Panel Review of Proposed Precept 2020/21

Thank you for your letter dated 4th February 2020 setting out formally the Panel's decision on my council tax and precept proposal for 2020/21.

I can confirm that it is my decision to increase the police element of the council tax in 2020/21 by 3.95%, this is an increase of £9.99 per year, which equates to £263.07 for a Band D property.
