Emerging Local Plans

Breckland

- Breckland Local Plan: Work formally commenced in November 2021. Will comprise a partial review of Policy INF 03 and a review of the whole Plan. Call for sites and issues and options consultations likely to be early 2022.

Broadland

- Greater Norwich Local Plan: Reg 22 – Local Plan Submitted for examination on 31st July 2021. Examination Hearings expected January to March 2022. Adoption is likely to be late 2022.

Broads Authority

- Broads Local Plan: Issues and Options version being drafted and some evidence underway. Issues and Options consultation expected in April/ May 2022.

Great Yarmouth

- Local Plan Part 2: Detailed Policies (Development Management) and Site Allocations DPD: Inspector's Report received. Local Plan Part 2 found sound subject to modifications. Adoption expected at Full Council on 9th December.

Kings Lynn and West Norfolk

- Local Plan review: Call for Sites and Policy Consultation (Reg18) October/ November 2016. Consultation on draft Local Plan review – March/ April 2019. Pre-submission draft Local Plan review consultation (Reg. 19) August/ September 2021. Submission to Secretary of State/ Planning Inspectorate (Reg 22) early 2022. Examination – anticipated hearings summer 2022; Main Modifications autumn 2022; adoption spring 2023.

Norfolk County Council

- M&W Local Plan Review (2036): Reg 18 consultation on the Preferred Options took place between 18 September to 30 October 2019. Reg 19 pre-submission expected Q1 2022.

North Norfolk

- Local Plan Review: Commenced August 2015
- Local Plan 2016-2036 – Core Strategy including Development Management Policies and Site Allocation Plan: Call for sites undertaken. Reg 18 Consultation May 2019. Pre Submission Reg 19 January 2022. Submission to Secretary of State/ Planning Inspectorate (Reg 22) expected spring/ summer 2022.

Norwich City

- Greater Norwich Local Plan: Reg 22 – Local Plan Submitted for examination on 31st July 2021. Examination Hearings expected January to March 2022. Adoption is likely to be late 2022.

South Norfolk

- Greater Norwich Local Plan: Reg 22 – Local Plan Submitted for examination on 31st July 2021. Examination Hearings expected January to March 2022. Adoption is likely to be late 2022.
- Village Clusters Housing Allocations Plan: Regulation 19 Consultation expected in March 2022.
