1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This document sets out the changes that the Applicant has made to the Draft DCO in the version submitted for Deadline 12 (2 December 2014), compared with its draft DCO dated 20 November 2014. The Applicant's revised draft DCO is document NCC/EX/103, and a comparison between that and the previous draft DCO has also been submitted (document NCC/EX/104).

	27: Paragraph (1) has been updated to refer to "rat running" and paragraph (2) to refer to potential traffic management measures to be adopted (although the list is not exclusive). Paragraph (3) has been inserted to ensure timely delivery of the approved measures (with a backstop of 6 months after the NDR opens) and paragraph (4) has been added to secure additional traffic management measures in the event that monitoring identifies a material increase in traffic directly associated with the NDR. These points were discussed at the hearing on 28 November 2014.
	The Applicant issued these amended versions of requirements 26 and 27 to Mr Hawker (Hockering Parish Council) and Ms Goodall (Weston Longville Parish Council) on 1 December 2014 following previous discussions with them and separately at the issue specific hearing on 28 November 2014. Provision in **Brief Description of and Explanation for Amendment Draft DCO** parties is at Appendix A, and includes text explaining why the Applicant does not consider that other changes requested by the Parish Councils (in recent submissions to the examination) are appropriate or required. The responses received from the Parish Council representatives are at Appendix B. The Applicant notes that both Parish Council representatives confirm that they are content with the revised form of the two requirements. The Applicant has also provided the updated text to Norfolk County Council as local planning authority, who confirmed (verbally to the Applicant) that they are content with the amendments. The Applicant has requested that the LPA confirm this in writing to the Examining Authority. Paragraph (1) has been updated to make clear that the listed 31 measures are not exclusive, as discussed at the hearing on 28 November 2014. Schedule 13 Protective provisions - Network Rail Part 1 Paras Minor typographical errors have been corrected in these paragraphs, 4(6),6(1) and 9(4) as previously set out in the Document NCC/EX/101 (Minor corrections to draft DCO).

<u>Applicant's Proposed Changes to DCO Requirements 26 and 27</u> (Suggested changes highlighted yellow)

Requirement 26: Routeing to Norwich International Airport and Cromer

- **26.**—(1) The NDR classified road must not open to traffic until details indicating the preferred routeing for vehicles travelling to and from the A47 (to the west of Norwich) to Norwich International Airport and Cromer have been submitted to and, following consultation with the Highways Agency, Broadland District Council, Norwich City Council and Breckland District Council, approved by the relevant planning authority.
- (2) Prior to the opening to traffic of the NDR classified road the signage for the approved routeing to and from the A47 to Norwich International Airport and Cromer must be displayed and afterwards maintained.

Requirement 27: Weston Longville and Hockering traffic

- 27. (1) Prior to the NDR classified road being open to traffic a scheme of traffic management measures to minimise 'rat running' through Weston Longville and Hockering must be submitted to and, following consultation with Broadland District Council and Breckland District Council, approved by the relevant planning authority.
- (2) The submitted scheme must include a timetable for implementation. The feasibility of traffic management measures to be considered should include (but not be limited to) the following:
 - imposition of speed limits,
 - flashing signs;
 - road humps or tables;
 - pinch-points: and
 - other physical barriers or impediments.
- (3) The approved scheme must be implemented in full in accordance with the approved timetable. The approved scheme must be completed and in use no later than 6 months after the opening of the NDR classified road.
- (4) In the event that post monitoring of traffic passing through Weston Longville and Hockering (in accordance with Requirement 30) identifies a material increase in traffic that could be directly associated with the NDR classified road, a further scheme of traffic management measures and a timetable for their implementation must be submitted to and, following consultation with Broadland District Council and Breckland District Council, approved by the relevant planning authority.
- (5) The approved scheme must be implemented in full in accordance with the approved timetable.

Applicants comments on other suggested changes by Weston Longville and Hockering Parish Councils

The Applicant does not consider it appropriate for the DCO to include a requirement that Hockering and Weston Longville Parish Councils should approve the routeing/signing to Norwich International Airport and Cromer from the A47 (Requirement 26) or traffic management measures (Requirement 27). This is because having multiple parties that must approve the proposals would not be workable. However the Applicant would consult with Parish Councils prior to submitting information to discharge the requirement, and the responses to that consultation would be taken into account and included with the submission to the relevant planning authority.

The Applicant does not consider that there is a need to include consultation with Hockering and Weston Longville Parish Councils in the DCO requirement. This is because the approach of including parish councils as consultees formally within requirements is not proposed generally in the DCO. However as above the Applicant would consult with Parish Councils prior to submitting information to discharge the requirement, and the responses to the consultation from the Parish Councils would be included with the submission to the relevant planning authority.

The Applicant does not consider that there is a need to include details of the pre and post NDR monitoring specifically for Hockering and Weston Longville in Requirement 27. This is because it will be undertaking pre and post NDR monitoring in general, and this is secured by Requirement 30.
