

# Route Instructions

1. Starting at the entrance to the wood, go through the gate and follow the well-defined track straight on. After approximately 500 yards, the track becomes grassy and you will reach a junction. Turn left following the path round to the boardwalk.
2. Walk along the boardwalk and at the end, turn left.
3. The path opens out to a sandy clearing. Bear slightly right and then bear left at the fork, following the path straight ahead rather than the sandy path to your right.
4. You will reach a waymarker post. Turn left here and follow the path as it winds back to the main track.
5. Turn right on to the main track and then you are back at your starting point.

Reffley Wood has a network of paths which means that you can explore further if you wish.
