Norfolk Police and Crime Panel – review of proposed precept for 2023/24, 2 February 2023, 11am

In accordance with Schedule 5 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, I write to confirm the Norfolk Police and Crime Panel's decision regarding your proposed precept for 2023/24.

The Panel voted to support your proposal to increase the policing element of council tax in 2023/24 by 5.19% (an increase of £14.94 per year for a Band D property), on the basis that the maximum increase should allow the Constabulary to continue to deliver the current level of policing services to Norfolk residents.

The Panel will continue to challenge and support you, to ensure that your commitments to our local communities are delivered.

On behalf of the Panel, I would like to thank you, your staff and the Chief Constable again for the extensive supporting information provided both before and during the meeting. The full discussion will be recorded in the minutes which will be published in due course.
