The route is neither currently on the Definitive Statement or Map. The width is that shown excluded from the hereditaments on the Finance Act 1910 IRS Duties on Land Valuation map, and the request is conditional on there being are no limitations or conditions on the use of the route by the public of which the supplicant is not aware.
