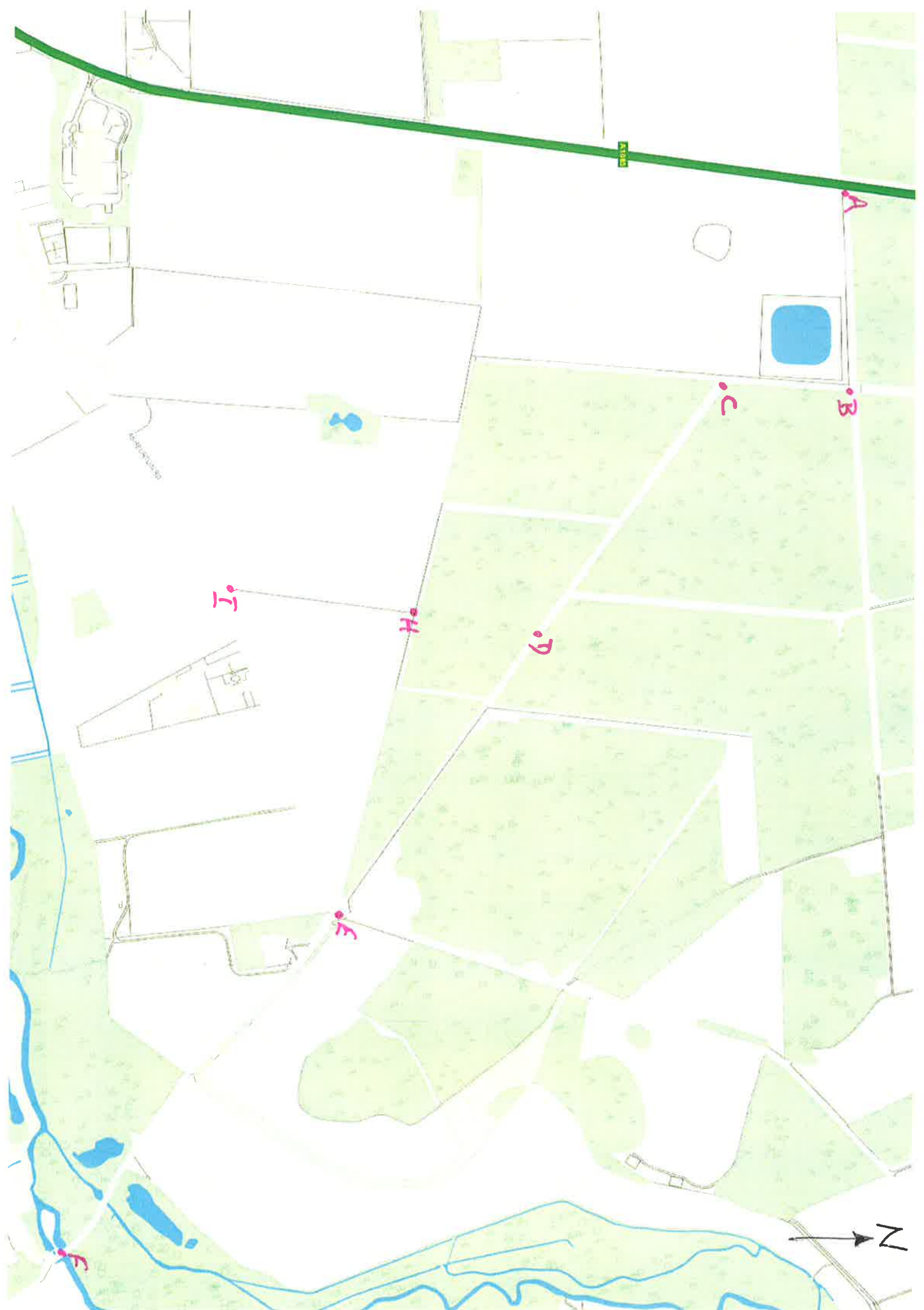


FIGURE 3. N.C.C. ONLINE FROW GAZETTEER, 2020 - APPLICATION ROUTES.
