#### **NORFOLK MINERALS SITE SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT: SINGLE ISSUE SILICA SAND REVIEW – DECEMBER 2017**

The Single Issue Silica Sand Review of the Norfolk Minerals Site Specific Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) was adopted by Norfolk County Council on 11 December 2017.

The Single Issue Silica Sand Review of the Norfolk Minerals Site Specific Allocations DPD is part of the Development Plan for Norfolk and includes planning policies to allocate sites and areas of search to meet Norfolk's need for minerals up to 2026. The document is adopted with the modifications recommended in the Inspector's report (Appendix – Main Modifications).

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Single Issue Silica Sand Review of the Norfolk Minerals Site Specific Allocations DPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any application must be made no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the DPD was adopted, i.e. by 22 January 2018.
