Bio Group are a Cambs-based company who are interested in investigating possible uses for AD liquid digestate as a growth medium for algae. In particular, Bio Group were interested in making R&D partnerships to accelerate progress.

InCrops supported Bio Group in applying to become a subpartner in the INTERREG project "Energetic Algae" (EnAlgae) which would enable the company to access funding and expertise held within the network.

InCrops also assisted Bio Group to secure a CASE studentship with the Department of Plant Sciences in Cambridge, an InCrops partner.

Following our support Bio Group were included as a subpartner in the EnAlgae project, enabling the company to access €120K of EU funding for their algal research at the Bio Group site.

Participation in the EnAlgae network will also grant Bio Group access to an enormous amount of practical expertise from the partners in the network.

The CASE studentship will enable the company to research algal communities in conjunction with algal ecologists in Cambridge.
