I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the County of Norfolk by 1. adding the Un-named Lane across Ling Common, Stanfield Parish, as a Restricted Byway, and by 2. upgrading its continuation (comprising Stanfield BR2, Brisley BR9, and Brisley BR8) as restricted byway.

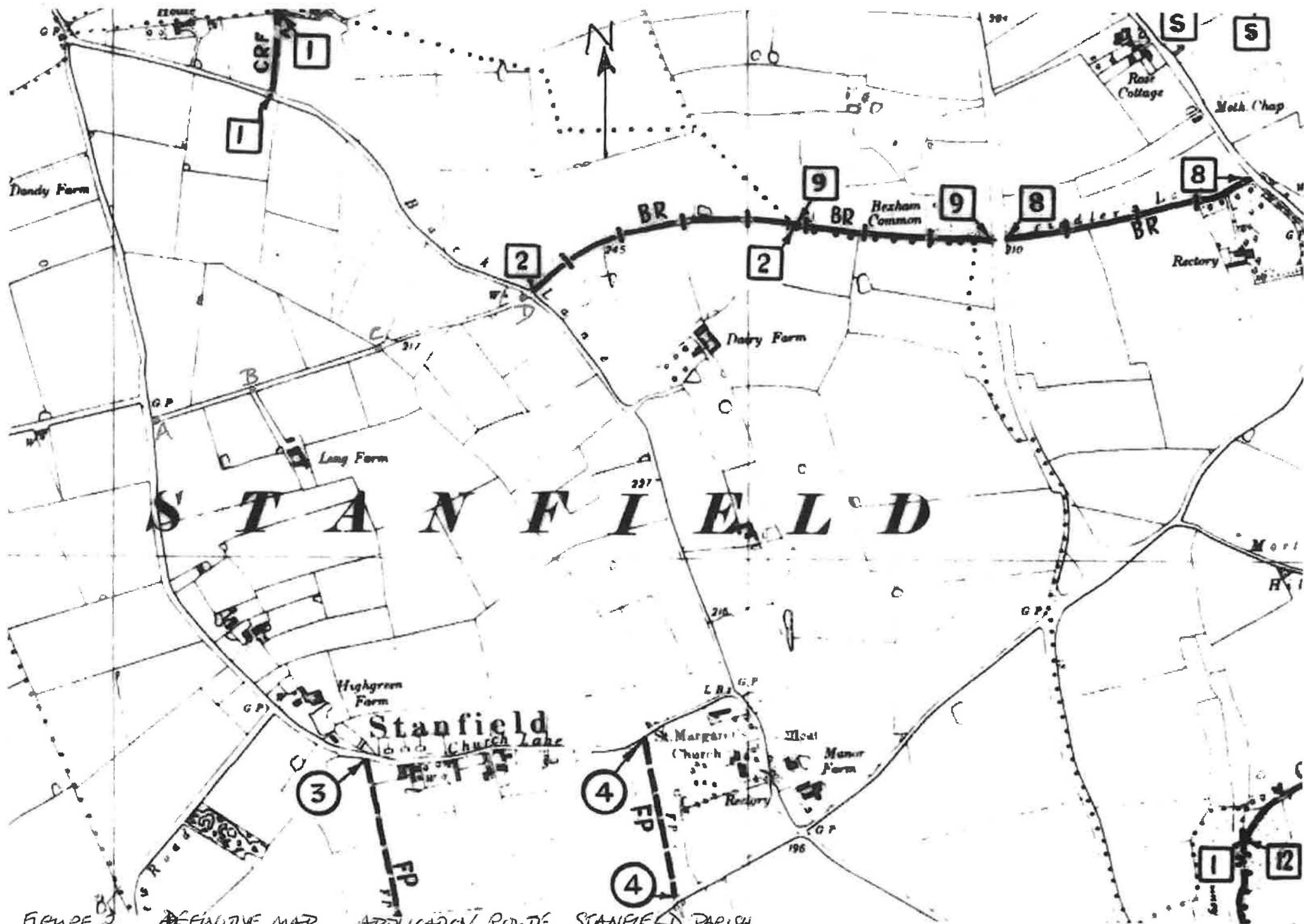


FIGURE 2. DEFINITIVE MAP APPLICATION ROUTE, STANFIELD PARISH
