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Introduction

As requested in the Examining Authority's Rule 17 letter dated 5 November 2014 the Applicant provided a Final Report on Compulsory Acquisition Issues (Document Reference NCC/EX/92) – since submitting that document the Applicant has discovered two additional representations made by affected parties. This document provides an update in respect of those parties, in a similar format to Document NCC/EX/92.

In addition, following the response made by Network Rail to the Examining Authority's Rule 17 request dated 5 November 2014, the Applicant has updated entries within the affected parties table to include details of all plots which the Category 1 and 2 affected parties have an interest in. The plots within brackets are the plots which the party has rights over and are detailed in Part 3 to the Book of Reference (Document Reference NCC/EX/79). Only those parties where there are changes to the table are included within this document.



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Updated extract of affected persons table

Category 1 and 2 party representations

1.1. Anna Ellis

- 1. Whilst a directly affected landowner the relevant representation made by Anna Ellis is not specifically about the compulsory acquisition of her land. It expresses general views regarding the environmental impact of the scheme and the necessity of the length from the A140 Cromer Road to the A1067 Fakenham Road.
- 2. The Applicant's Comments on Relevant Representations (Document Reference NCC/EX/4) contains a number of responses to various of these points, Volume 2, paragraph 2.1.2 onwards (page 5) specifically deals with environmental impacts; cost is discussed at paragraph 2.3.2 onwards (page 7) and need is covered in paragraph 2.7 (page 15) of the same document.
- 3. The justification of the route between the A140 and the A1067 was raised by the Examining Authority in their First Written Questions to the Applicant. The response can be found in the Applicant's Responses to the Examining Authority's (ExA's) First Written Questions (Document Reference NCC/EX/5), paragraph 10.3.1 onwards (page 167).



Category 3 party representations

2.1. Mrs Cheshem-Panam

- A Relevant Representation was submitted by Mrs Cheshem-Panam regarding the proximity of her property to the Scheme and the likely impact it would have on her property and its value. She requested a discussion on these issues with the Applicant.
- 2. As well as submitting her representation Mrs Cheshem-Panam also contacted the Applicant directly with these issues.
- 3. Email correspondence between the parties in October 2014 is included below. No further contact has been received from Mrs Cheshem-Panam.
- 4. A further email was sent to Mrs Cheshem-Panam on 25 November 2014 notifying her of the forthcoming examination hearing and seeking confirmation that the information provided earlier had satisfactorily resolved her issues. No response has been received to date.

Your email to Norwich Transport has been forwarded to myself for a response as I am dealing with land and compensation issues related to the NDR.

There are currently no further examination hearings programmed by the Examining Authority. There will almost certainly be one at the end of November but this will be solely in relation to a modification to the scheme at Drayton. The Examining Authority will publish details of this on their website - http://infrastructure.planningportal.gov.uk/projects/eastern/norwich-northern-distributor-road-ndr/

With regard to your particular impact, for properties that do not have land acquired for the scheme there is the potential to make a claim for compensation one year after the road has opened to traffic. This is known as a 'Part 1 claim' and some guidance on this is attached for your information. Whether or not such a claim would be successful could only be assessed at that time.

I trust that the provided information is useful but if you have any further concerns or queries please let me know.
