I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

For the section of Fincham Drove that is within South Acre Parish and which currently has no public right of way, to be classified as a Restricted Byway - supported by considerable historical data. The remainder of Fincham Drove is within Swaffham Parish and is currently a Bridleway, Swaffham BR2 and 3. It is proposed that the historical data supports that this section should be upgraded to a Restricted Byway, creating a consistent designation along the surviving span of this ancient public highway.


