Conditions

Applicants must be registered for explosives storage in accordance with the Explosives Regulations 2014 and have an issued storage registration or license issued by Norfolk Fire & Rescue Licensing Authority.

Regulation 10 of the Fireworks Regulations 2004 requires sellers to maintain records of certain transactions for three years from the date of supply.

If, in a single transaction, the total amount of explosives (net explosive content or NEC) contained in the fireworks supplied exceeds 50kg the following Information must be recorded:-

- the name and address of your supplier for those fireworks and the date of supply
- the name and address of the person to whom you supply the fireworks and date of supply
- the total amount of explosives contained in the fireworks supplied (NEC information is usually printed on the delivery cartons)

Licence Fee

Regulation 9(7) of the Fireworks Regulations 2004 sets a fixed fee of **£500 per annum** for a licence to supply fireworks. A cheque for £500, made payable to NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL should accompany this application.

'Adult firework' means: -

- (a) any firework which does not comply with the relevant requirements of Part 2 of BS 7114 when tested in accordance with the appropriate test method (if any) in Part 3 of BS 7114; or
- (b) any firework (except for a cap (amorce), cracker snap, novelty match, party popper, serpent, sparkler or throwdown) which does comply with those requirements.
- (c) Pyrotechnics Articles (Safety Regulations) 2010 CE marked and tested by third party in accordance with Regulations

Warning

Any false declaration made in this application may give rise to criminal prosecution and/or the subsequent revocation of the licence.
