I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Norfolk by adding Highmoor Drove in Foulden and Northwold parishes as a Restricted Byway, instead of as a Footpath.

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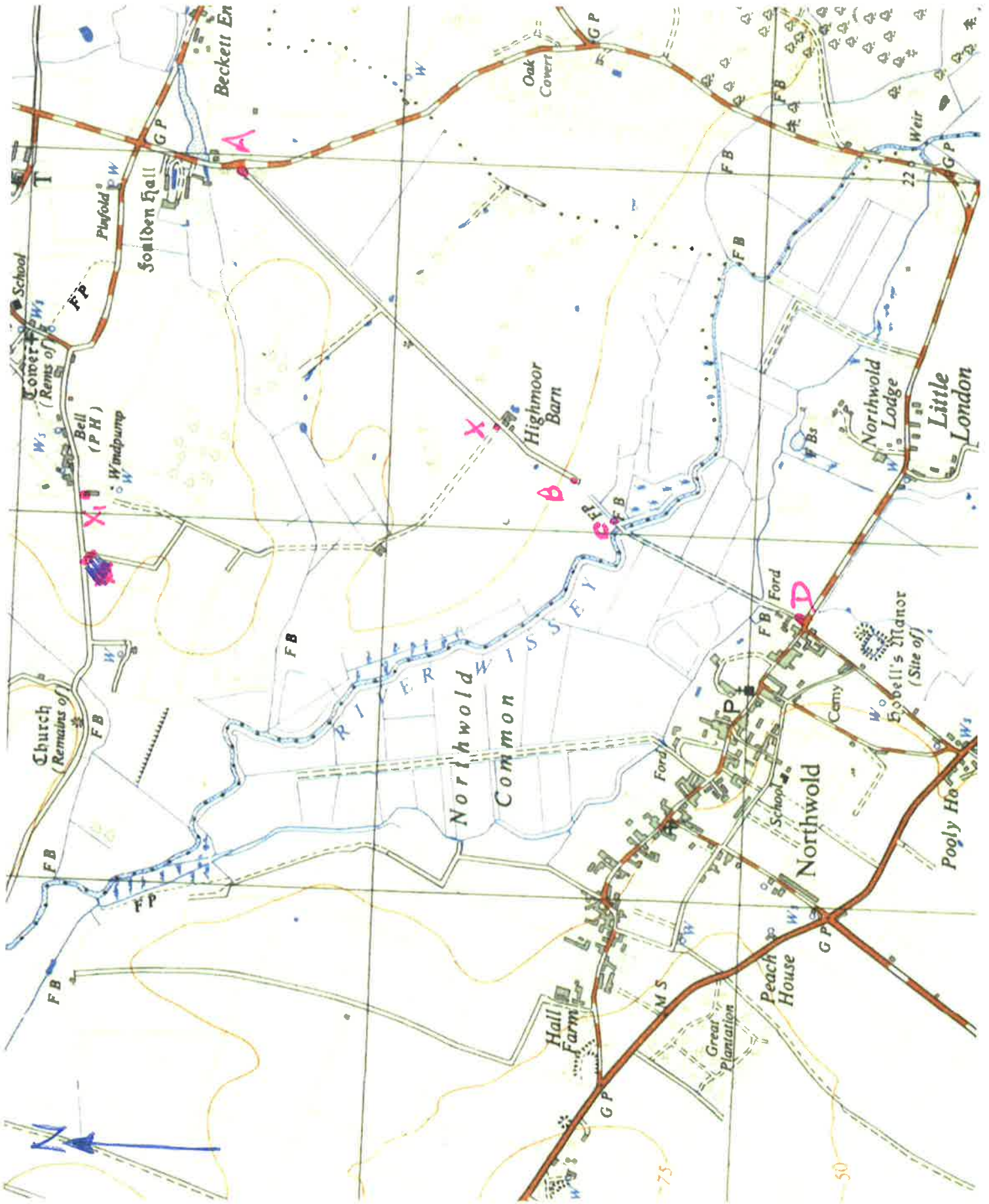
