

I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by registering the former public highway, Sandringham RUPP 2. This public right of way was inappropriately extinguished on the Sandringham Estate during the original deliberations regarding the formation of the Definitive Map in the 1950s. As the N.C.C. Definitive Statement website explains, the Sandringham Estate administration claimed exemption from public rights of way as they were part of the Crown Estate. The Estate is actually a private estate of Her Majesty the Queen, and was not entitled to claim this exemption. As a consequence, the public rights of way continue. Almost seventy years later, and neither the Estate nor the Surveying Authority have corrected this error. It is now imperative that this public right of way is re-established as otherwise it will be lost in perpetuity.

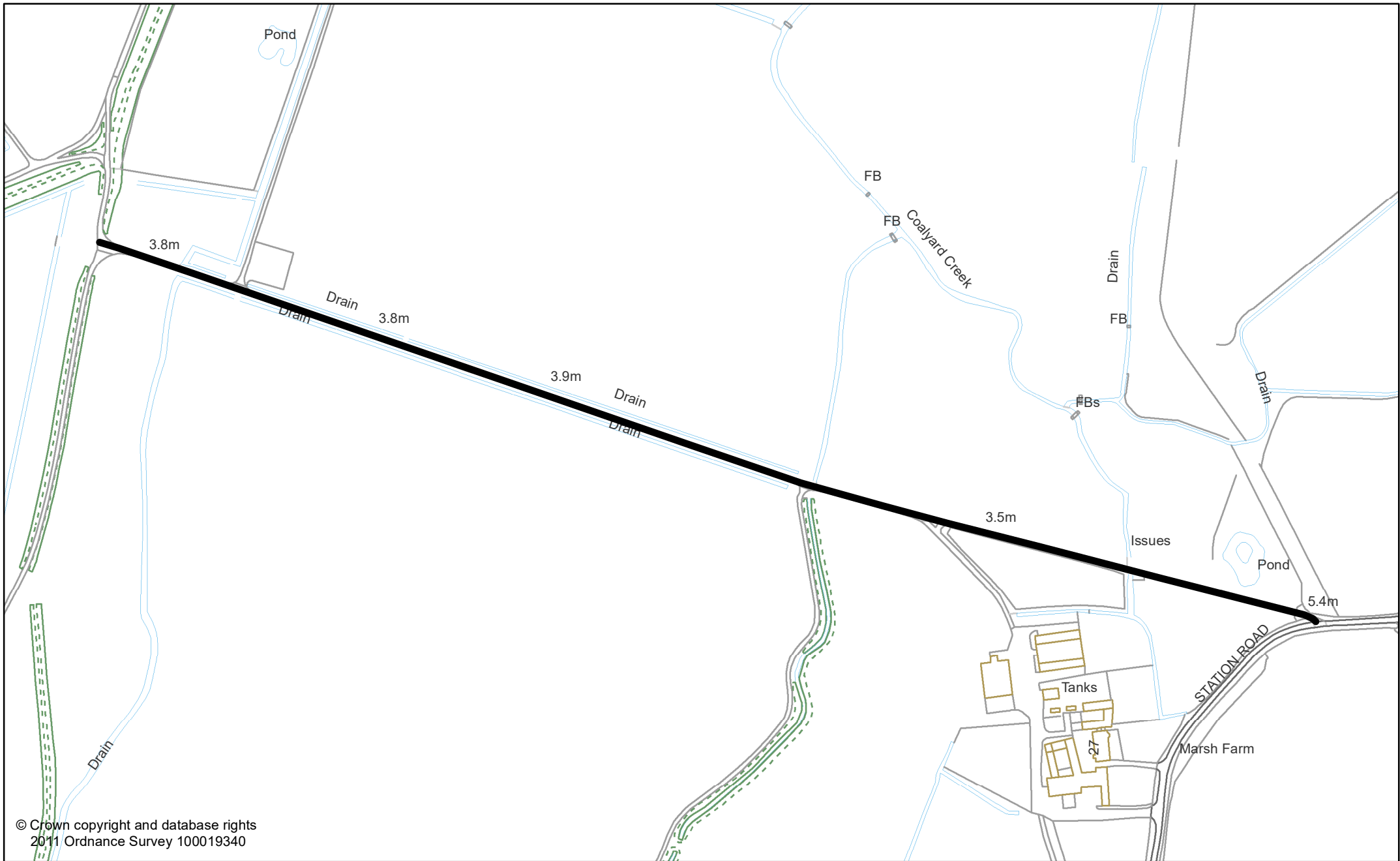
