
adding the restricted byway from Cart Gap Road (U 19154), at the grid reference TG 3974 2990 to the Happisburgh Restricted Byway No. 22 at the grid reference TG 3915 3025 in the parish of Happisburgh

and adding to the particulars of the aforementioned way, and also of the restricted byway from the grid reference TG 3915 3025 to the beach, by providing that the width is that shown excluded from the hereditaments on the Finance Act 1910 Valuation Plan and that there are no limitations or conditions on the use of the route by the public

and shown on the map accompanying this application.
