

**The Commons Act 2006, application under section 19
The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.
Application for the correction of the Common Rights Register relating to
common land at Burnham Overy, Burnham Norton and Brancaster- CL65**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Mr Peter Connor to Norfolk County Council as Commons Registration Authority, for the correction of the Common Rights Register for CL65 on the basis of a mistake made by the Norfolk County Council in registering East Coast Sporting Ltd as the owner of a common right (entry number 328).

A summary of the effect of the application under section 19 is as follows: namely that a mistake has been made by allowing a common right to be transferred to a company and then recording that transferral of ownership on the common rights register under entry number 328. The applicant considers that the Registration Authority mistakenly relied on section 34 of the Law of Property Act 1925. The applicant states that common rights are not personal property and are only held as an interest. As a result, the applicant states that entry 328 should be removed from the register

For information, the right in question permits the common right holder to take herbage, estovers, samphire, soil, fish, shellfish, bait and wildfowl from the whole of the common land described and comprised in register unit CL65, being Creeks, Foreshore and Salt Marshes at Burnham Overy, Burnham Norton and Brancaster in Norfolk. The application for the registration of the transfer to East Coast Sporting Limited was made on 27 November 2014 under reference number 3336 and entry 328 to register that transfer was made on 11 March 2015.

If the application is granted the registration authority will give effect to the determination by removing East Coast Sporting Limited as a right holder from entry number 328 from the register of common land for Unit CL65


