

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, leasee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the Norfolk County Council by the Friends of Whittome Mill of C/O Lynette Hyslop, Wherry House, Whittome Mill, Hilgay PE38 0LB under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007.

The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 9 May 2021 by virtue of the indulgence by a significant number of inhabitants of Whittome Mill and Holts Lane in the parish of Hilgay, Borough of King's Lynn and West Norfolk as of right in lawful sports and pastimes for a period of 20 years. The land has been used for general recreation, socialising for wellbeing, barbeques, picnics, community celebrations, Royal event celebrations, lawful sports, dog walking, people walking, bird watching, bird boxes erected, children play and bike riding and carol singing.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration and the supporting documents may be inspected at Norfolk County Council, Community and Environmental Services, County Hall, Martineau Lane, Norwich, NR1 2DH during normal office hours. Appointments are preferable and can be made by telephoning (01603) 224253 or emailing legalordersandregisters@norfolk.gov.uk. The application form, which includes a plan of the land which is claimed as a new Village Green may also be inspected at the offices of the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk, Kings Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, Norfolk, PE30 1EX during normal office hours.


If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based addressed to the Senior Legal Orders Officer, Legal Orders and Registers, Community and Environmental Services, Norfolk County Council, County Hall, Martineau Lane, Norwich, NR1 2SG or by email to legalordersandregisters@norfolk.gov.uk on or before 20th June 2022.

Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.

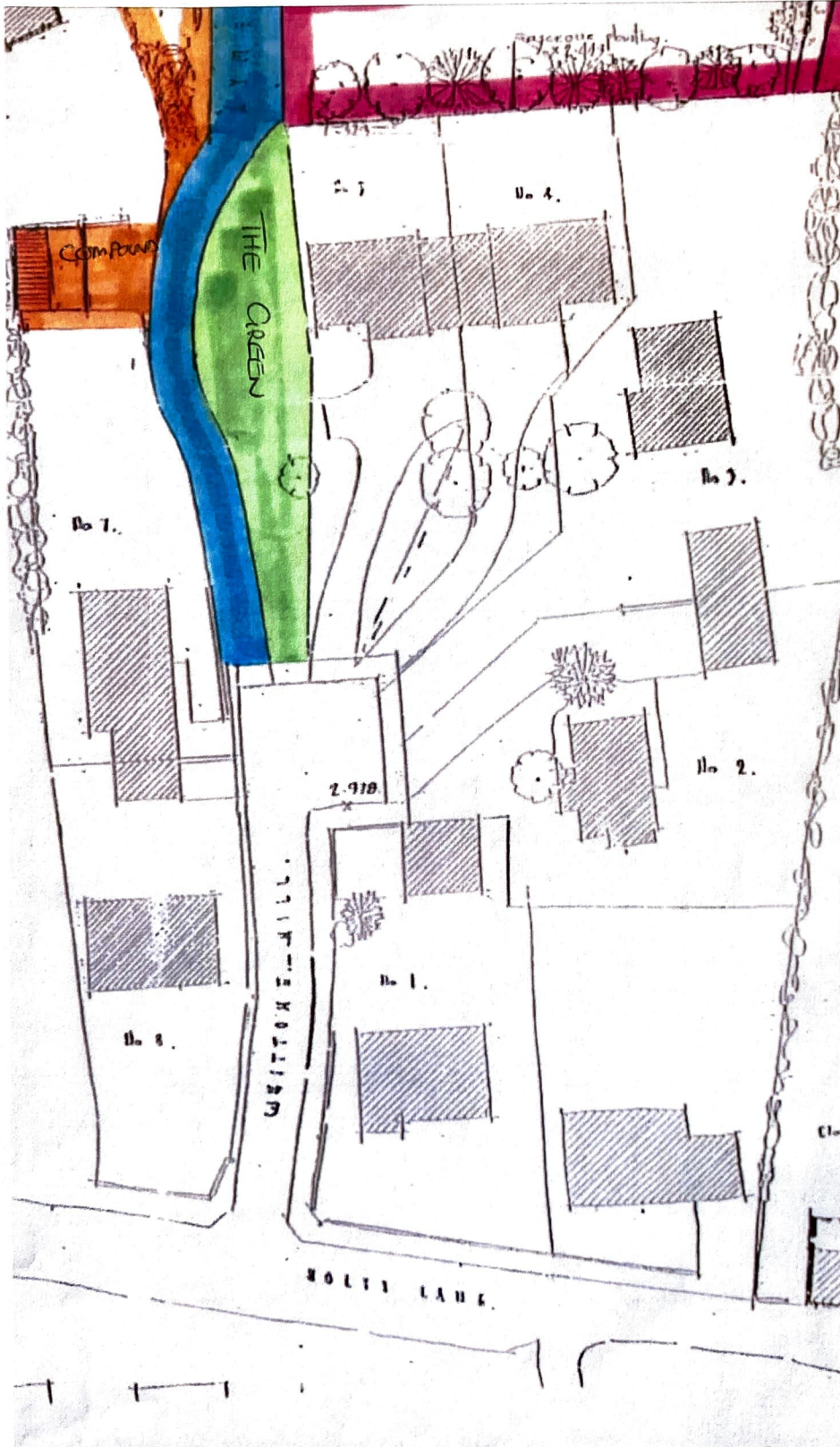
Description of the land claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green:-
