Update - Emergency Road Closure - Stow Causeway Bridge - TF60109

Update STOW CAUSEWAY BRIDGE (TF60109), we are now in the position to install a temporary support in place of the missing bearing, which is being installed on the 23rd November 2023. This will allow the bridge to be open to all normal traffic including HGV's by the weekend. We are now looking at a long term repair solution, which at some stage will require the bridge to be closed to all traffic, this may also include all pedestrian movements over the bridge. Consultation will take place with all affected businesses, to see what is the best time of year to carry out permanent repairs to minimise disruption.

The signed diversion route will remain in place until the bridge re-opens with pedestrian access being maintained at all times.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this emergency closure is in place.

The work will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
