Ringland Bridge TG11300 – Emergency Weight Restriction **Previous 7.5T Weight Limit Now Reduced to 3T Limit** **with Immediate Effect**

The previous weight limit of 7.5T for Ringland Bridge TG11300 will be revoked and a lower weight limit of 3T imposed with immediate effect.

This emergency weight restriction follows inspections of Ringland Bridge which have identified significant deterioration in the structure, which may be worsened if heavy vehicle loadings continue over the bridge.

A scheme for repairing Ringland Bridge and reinstating the 7.5T restriction is being investigated.

In the meantime, the 3T restriction will be in place, and regular inspections will be carried out to monitor for any further deterioration in the structure.

A Plan showing the bridge position and 3T restriction is shown on the attached drawing numbered **PMZ018-TG11300-P03**.

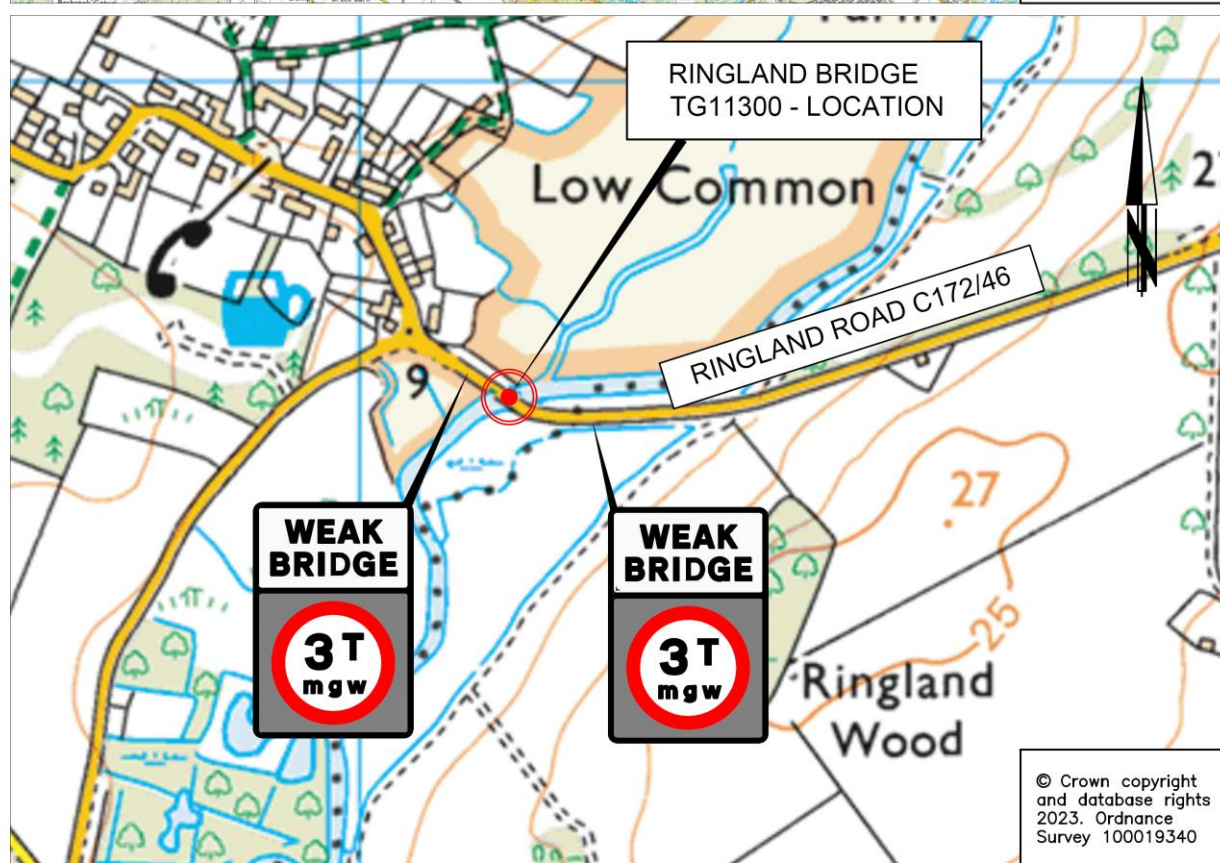
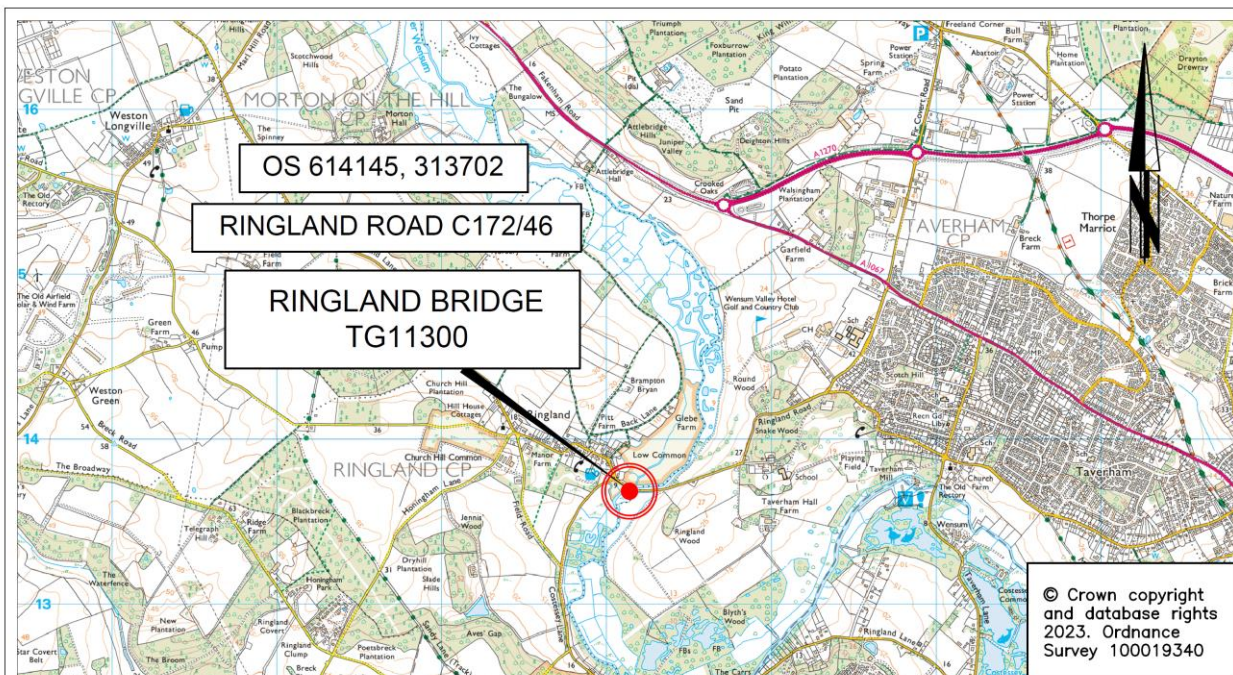
