Local Plan Update

- 1. This report provides a short update in relation to Local Plan preparation for all Norfolk Authorities.
- All Authorities in the County have adopted Core Strategies covering various plan periods ending between 2021 (North Norfolk) and 2030 (Yarmouth). There are adopted Site Allocation Plans in Norwich, Broadland, South Norfolk, North Norfolk, Broads Authority, Breckland and Kings Lynn and West Norfolk.
- 3. All Authorities have commenced, or will soon commence work on Plan reviews and will produce new Local Plan documents extending to at least 2036. Yarmouth which already has a Core Strategy covering the period to 2030 may plan to 2041.
- 4. Work on these new Plans is at various stages with Breckland and the Broads Authority the most advanced having recently completed consultations on key options and preparing their Plans for submission. The GNDP authorities and North Norfolk are broadly at the same stage having commenced Plan review and undertaken a call for sites, some evidence gathering, and initial Regulation 18 consultation. Kings Lynn and West Norfolk are just commencing plan review and Yarmouth plan to commence their review in 2018.

Joint Evidence Preparation

5. As part of the Duty to Co-operate the Authorities have agreed to commission a number of evidence documents as outlined below. These are informing the preparation of the Norfolk Strategic Framework and individual/joint Local Plans. The process of commissioning evidence and project management has inevitably been slightly more complex and time consuming as there is a need to reconcile the needs of a number of authorities. Set against this, although a detailed cost comparison has not been prepared, joint commissioning will have saved many thousands of pounds.
