C585 Matsell Way Dereham, improvements to traffic signal controlled junction.

Work to improve the pedestrian crossing on C585 Matsell Way is currently programmed to be carried out on or soon after 22 January 2024. The work is expected to take 8 weeks to complete, weather permitting. These works include the widening of the pedestrian crossing on Matsell Way, road surface maintenance and pavement resurfacing on the east side of Matsell Way as well as ducting works.

To ensure that work can be completed safely, C585 Matsell Way will need to be closed to vehicular through traffic for the duration of the works, there will be a signed diversion route in place to direct traffic around the closure. This closure will be from C585 Matsell Way junction with C496 Norwich Road to a point 90 meters North of Matsell Way junction with C496 Norwich Road.

Access will be maintained throughout for residents although there may be some unavoidable delays during this time. Access through the temporary closure for emergency vehicles will be managed by the site operatives.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this improvement work is carried out.

The work will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
